The Nobel Prize for literature recognizes modern classics and the efforts of authors to bridge gaps between different cultures, time-periods and styles. Below is a list of the prizewinners during the period 1996 – 2000. (1996) WISLAWA SZYMBORSKA – for poetry that with ironic precision allows the historical and biological context to come to light in fragments of human reality; (1997) DARIO FO – who emulates the jesters of the Middle Ages in scourging authority and upholding the dignity of the down-trodden; (1998) JOSE SARAMAGO – who with parables sustained by imagination, compassion and irony continually enables us once again to apprehend an elusory reality; (1999) GUNTER GRASS – whose frolicsome black fables portray the forgotten face of history; (2000) GAO XINGJIAN – for an oeuvre of universal validity, bitter insights and linguistic ingenuity, which has opened new paths for the Chinese novel and drama.
