From there he follows Tammy Parnell, the proprietor of Two Elves with a Twist, a company that decorates other people's houses for Christmas; Jeff and Bridgett Trykoski, owners of that one house every town has with Christmas decorations visible from space; and single mother Carroll Cavazos, who hopes that the life-affirming moments of Christmas might overcome the struggles of the rest of the year.
